### ATTENDANCE

Some parents may have received attendance letters over the last week. Attendance is reviewed every term and any child who has less than 96% attendance receives a letter home informing parents of their child's current attendance. This is reported in the number of sessions missed since the start of the school year. A session counts as either a morning or an afternoon, so every day your child is off counts as 2 sessions. For an example an attendance of 90% equates to your child missing the equivalent of 1 afternoon of school every week throughout the year. We do understand that the reasons for absence may be genuine, especially this time of year when there is a lot of illness around. However we also feel that it is important to keep parents informed. If you would like to discuss this further then please feel free to arrange a meeting via the school office.
