FREE SCHOOL MEALS

In addition to your child receiving free school meals, the school also receive additional funding to help support your child in school.

ROAD SAFETY

We are aware that parking is difficult at the moment however please **do not** use the entrance to the school as a place to turn your car. The entrance is for pedestrians only and priority must be given to the maintaining the safety of all children, families and staff.

ATTENDANCE

Ongoing low attendance is a key factor often linked to low levels of academic success. It is important that parents work in partnership with the school to build an enthusiasm for learning and a good record of attendance.

Any child with an attendance below 96% will be closely monitored until it improves to ensure it is dealt with as early as possible to prevent poor habits forming. If your child has an attendance of 95% or below this is the equivalent of missing 1 afternoon or morning every week of the school year.

In addition, we must reiterate that taking

holidays during term time will not be authorised. Anyone wishing to do so must complete a holiday request for from the office. If you do not meet the exceptional circumstances criteria, then you may be issued a penalty notice under section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. The initial penalty is £60 per parent of each child of compulsory school age if paid with 21 days or £120 if paid within 28 days.

We do break up earlier in July and have an additional week holiday in October and we would encourage parents to use these times for family holidays.

MATHS CHALLENGE

Well done to Year 1 and Year 2 this week who completed an online maths competition throughout the week against other schools in the Trust. There was a lot of engagement and we were really proud to have had the highest score on Wednesday. Well done to all those involved.
