### NEXT WEEKS CLASS TRIP

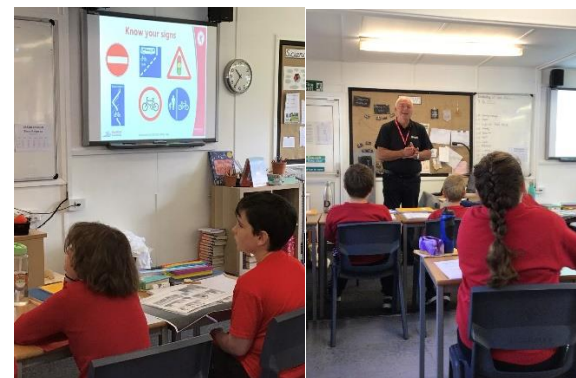
