Buzzard class will be visiting Caerleon as part of their learning enquiry "The Romans in Britain". The consent form and payment are now available on Reach More Parents to be completed.

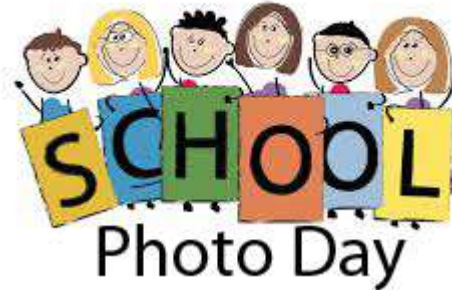
