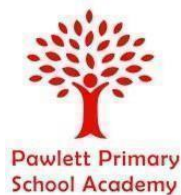

Community Club is all about.. you guessed it.. the Community! Each week we will be doing something different for our local community, including the

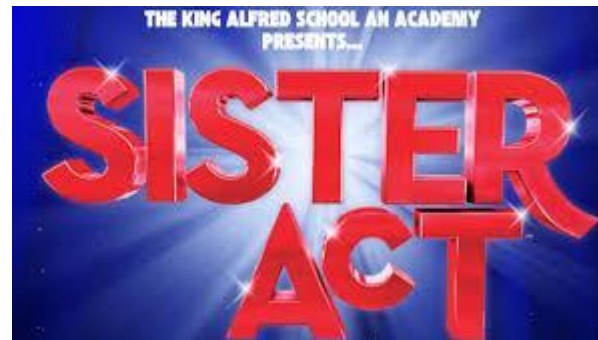
Church, Pavilion and Royal British Legion.
